Ambassador to a Local Church

Reports to: Ambassador Director

Summary: Promotes Gospel Outreach at a local Adventist church.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Works with the local pastor, head elder, and/or Sabbath School Superintendent to get time on a regular basis to promote Gospel Outreach from the front.
 - A 3-minute video will be provided once a quarter which can be shown
 - Quantities of *Adventures in Missions* newsletters will be sent upon request, for distribution.
 - Other collaterals (brochures, flyers, etc.), as they are developed, will be made available.
- Keeps current with Gospel Outreach so that when church members ask questions the Ambassador can articulate the mission, share an inspirational mission story, tell about the needs of the people in the 10/40 Window, etc.
- Prays daily for Gospel Outreach and the people in the 10/40 Window who are being introduced to Jesus; for the success of the Bible workers, teachers, and healthcare workers that GO sponsors.
- Once a year invites church members to:
 - Sign up for the *Adventures in Missions* newsletter.
 - Support the mission of Gospel Outreach (Giving Tuesday or during the Christmas season are great times to make an offering appeal).
